COURSE LEVEL

The course page is the primary area seen by students who directly login to Realizeit or those where the LTI activation is configured to land at this level.

The course page is now displayed as one vertically aligned page with expandable areas. Previously, each area was presented on a seperate tab. Now, the user can see all areas in one scrollable view. Details of these areas are covered in the following subsections.

This new course page also contains an expanable area called 'What this is about'. This displays an image and descriptive text about the course/product.


What this is about










Objective list with description toggled on:




COMPETENCIES LIST

The competencies are now presented as a list in an expanable area of the course page. Each competency set is independently expandable showing the individual competencies. Clicking on the competency set displays all the activities in a map for the entire set. Clicking on an individual competency displays the map for that competency.




ASSESSMENTS LIST



The values displayed are now clickable, containing the score and question information rather than the *Show* and *Questions* buttons used previously.




OBJECTIVES LEVEL


The objective level is the primary area seen by students who connect to Realizeit using LTI. This level can also be accessed by others by selecting an objective from the course level.

The objectives page has been redesigned.

- The 'What to do next' area has been split into 'What you should do next' and 'Learning map' areas. The first focuses on selecting a next steps, while the second allows for more agency.
- The 'What you have done so far' has been moved to the top and provides some information regarding the lastest activities completed by the user in the objective.
- There is also a new 'What is this about' area which displays image and description associated with the objective.





COMPOSITE SCORE

Clicking on the composite score now provides a description of the factors contributing to the score. This also contains suggestions on how to improve this score. The suggestions are active links which take the user to the suggested activity.

ALTERNATIVE STEPS

'Alternative steps' has been included as a button from within the 'What you should do next' area. Previously, the list of alernative steps was obtained by clicking on the downward arrow in the 'What to do next' header area. These are now presented in an inline list rather than a pop up list. Each alternative option contains some text to provide some context around the action e.g. 'Practice objective' explains that 'This is a great way to improve and build on your existing knowledge..'.




ACTIVITY LINKS

Previously, the link for '15 activities' brought the user to the learning map. This link was located beneath the objective name. Since the learning map is now presented in an area called 'Learning map', there are two links available. The 'Learning map' link takes the user to the learning map while the '15 activities' link takes the user to a list version of the activities in the map.




Links to the learning map:

ACTIVITY SYMBOLS


The mastery bands are now displayed as solid circles and include 'check' symbols to indicate that the activity is complete (i.e. at some point the pass rate was achieved). The partially filled circles are still available for visually impaired students through an accessibility setting. In this case, the color changes to a high contrast black and white.


ESTIMATED MASTERY

When the user clicks on an activity they have not yet attempted, they are now shown a 'Your estimated level'. This is the predicted ability value.




COMPETENCIES




LESSON LEVEL

SKIPPING SECTIONS

A confirmation message/pop up is presented when a user chooses to skip/remove a section within the activity. The user can choose to confirm or cancel.




Once a section is skipped by a user, they now have the option to 'Add back skipped section'. This will insert the skipped section back into the learning path.



PRACTICE ACTIVITY

If a student starts a practice on an activity, then an 'Add content' option is available, allowing the student to insert the learning content into their pathway.



REMEDIATION

When the question block has been configured to 'Abandon the lesson', remediation/suggestions have been reintroduced.
