

# Curriculum Templates

## FEATURE OVERVIEW

---

The **Curriculum template** feature allows for curricula in Realizeit to be designated as templates. A template can then be selected when creating a new curriculum to provide a copy of the node structure, along with many of the node and prerequisite settings. This provides a mechanism to quickly create new curriculum in Realizeit that follow similar patterns.

## FEATURE USE

---

The curriculum definition includes a new field for indicating if that curriculum should be treated as a template by the system.

The curriculum templates can then be selected at the point of creating a new curriculum. This is possible using the new **Product dashboard** or the traditional way. The new curriculum will contain the same node structures as the template.
