# Product Dashboard

# FEATURE OVERVIEW

The **Product dashboard** is a new area for course developers to create and manage products in Realizeit. This provides a quick and easy way to create a product, create a version, and refresh a version. It displays recently used and favorite products, as well as products that have been searched for. The page displays 10 at a time, with each product displayed as its own tile. Information such as when each product was last refreshed is easily visible from this dashboard.




Figure 1 Product dashboard

# **FEATURE USE**

From any area of the system, the course developer can access the **Product dashboard** by selecting the **Workflow dashboard** icon in the top right-hand corner of the screen, as illustrated in Figure 2.

The *Product dashboard* can also be configured as the default landing page for the course developer when they enter the system. To do this, select the course developer's personal profile, select *Edit settings*, select *Workflow* as *Default start location*, and select *Save settings*. Now, when the user logs in, they will be directed straight to the *Product dashboard*.

By default, the *Product dashboard* displays the products the course developer has used most recently. However, the course developer can ensure that certain products remain on the *Product dashboard* by marking them as favorites. This is done by selecting the icon highlighted in Figure 3. The user can also search for an existing product to edit or pin.

## **CREATING A PRODUCT**

A product can be created by selecting the *Create product* button. When selected, a pop-up appears (as illustrated in Figure 4) with a variety of options for use in product creation. The basic options include product name, and creating a curriculum along with the product. Advanced options are available by selecting the *More* button.

## **CREATING A VERSION OF A PRODUCT**

Each product tile on the dashboard displays the versions of that product that have been created. If more than two exist, a *Show all* button will be available to see all versions, as illustrated in Figure 5.

The course developer can create a version of a product directly from the *Product dashboard*. Each product tile has a *Create version* button, as highlighted in Figure 6. When selected, a *Create version* pop-up appears with various options.

#### **REFRESHING VERSION FROM BASE PRODUCT**




Figure 7 Refresh version from base product pop-up

Each product version has a *Refresh* button next to it, which the course developer can use to refresh the version from base. When this button is selected pop-up appears to confirm the action, as illustrated in Figure 7. If *Refresh* is selected, the version will be refreshed from base.

The course developer can access *Content validation and search* for a product from the *Product dashboard*. Each product tile has a *More* button that provides access to the feature.
