FEATURE OVERVIEW

A new lesson delivery mode has been added, called **View content**. This mode allows content to be examined, without questions and without stepping through it in the usual way. No evidence of mastery will be provided from this delivery mode. The term **View content** can be customized.

Access to this new delivery mode is controlled using the product. The configuration is found in the **More advanced details** area of the product definition page. To enable this functionality

- In the *More advanced details* section, go to the *New user interface* area.

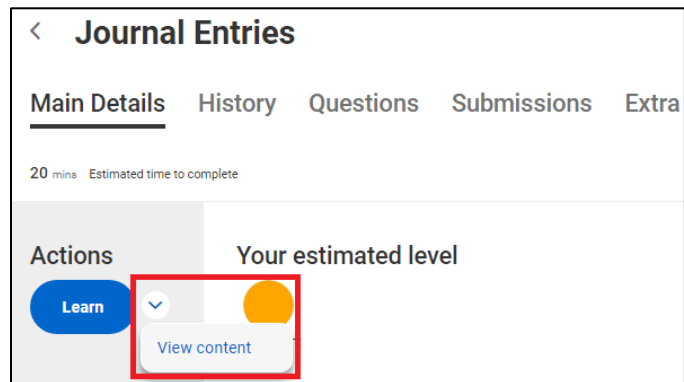

USER EXPERIENCE

Once enabled, a **View content** button will be available in the **Main Details** area of activities.




When a lesson is delivered in this mode, the content from all available learning sections is shown without questions. Questions sections and Interactive example sections are deliberately excluded, whereas Worked example sections are included.

View content: Introduction to Management

Introduction Section

The *Introduction* section is generally a short overview of the topic to be covered. It may also recap some of the materials from one or more of the previous lessons. This provides the student with guidance of what is going to be covered in this lesson.



As a student begins a lesson, they are automatically placed on a pathway through different types of pedagogical material. These types often include:

- **Introduction** - the lesson is introduced to the student
- **Learning** - the main concepts are presented and covered
- **Examples** - the concepts are reinforced with examples
- **Worked examples** - students are interactively brought step by step through examples
- **Questions** - the student is assessed on their knowledge of the concept
- **Summary** - the lesson is summarized for the student

The student is free to edit their path at any time. They can add in more material that they want to cover, and even jump ahead to any desired point.
