

Color blind visual impairment

User Guide

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FEATURE OVERVIEW

A new “Visual impairment” setting has been introduced for “Color only”. This will not prevent matching, ordering or point/click questions from being delivered. Other characteristics of the visual impairment setting will still apply.

DETAILS

A user who indicates a visual impairment in their personal settings can now further refine this to indicate that the impairment is color blindness only.

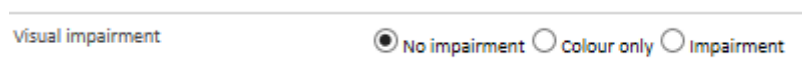


Figure 1 Visual impairment settings.

The available settings are visible in Figure 1.

When the *Color only* setting is selected the following question types will be available for delivery to the user:

- matching questions
- ordering questions
- point/click questions

LEARNER EXPERIENCE

Selecting the *Color only* setting has the effect of allowing questions involving drag and drop or clicking to be delivered to the learner.

Figure 2 shows a student with this setting receiving an ordering question.

This is an **ordering** question. Here a student has to arrange the objects shown on screen in an appropriate order.

For the following countries, arrange them in descending order by total land area.
