

OVERVIEW

1	Corrected an issue with tasks being processed as part of a service definition.	Backend >> Workflow
2	<p>When creating a product version, if the system detected that it can copy package contents from a base to version without having to go through the full versioning process then it was copying the latest package files from the base, without accounting for the configuration that allowed the latest approved file to be published.</p> <p>Now, after copying the directory contents, the system will check each source package file to determine if a historical file should be used – if this is the case then the contents of the historical file will be copied to the package version as the package file.</p>	Backend » Authoring
3	<p>Some event settings were not being copied to “repeat” events when they were created. This has been corrected.</p> <p>Calls to save again after a confirmation message were failing in some cases. This has been corrected.</p>	Backend » Calendar events
4	In certain cases when a learner tried to resume a lesson the content was not delivered successfully. This has been corrected.	Front end » Learner UI
5	Corrected a UI issue that occurred when a calendar was opened.	Front end » Learner UI
6	Some users were failing to login due to the culture passed in the request impacting the date format. This has been corrected.	Front end » Login

7	<p>Correction to a case where the logic to check access rights when changing rubric data did not account for people shown on the rubric being in different teams.</p> <p>When a rubric for a node is accessed from Employee, the system will now use any identified groupings to verify access control.</p>	Front end » Employee
8	<p>Improvements made to the user experience where a video upload has failed, for example due to a temporary loss of connectivity, to make it clearer that the upload has failed and that there is an option to retry.</p> 	Front end » Employee
9	<p>Improvements in the video capture UI - in the video capture panel an unnecessary Description element has been removed, and Type now only appears if there is more than one option to display</p>	Front end » Employee
10	<p>Cases have occurred where a user was able to upload a 0 byte video, and where an incorrect duration of a video was shown. These issues were not reproduced, but we have made some changes aimed at making the process more robust.</p>	Front end » Employee
